Project Lifesaver

If you have concerns about loved ones wandering due to Alzheimer's or other related mental dysfunction disorders, Project Lifesaver is an internationally recognized technology-based program that can locate patients before they fall prey to accidents or the elements, as well as ease the burden of family and caregivers.

Individuals who are clients of Project Lifesaver wear a personalized wristband that emits a constant tracking signal on a unique radio frequency enabling the search and rescue team to positively locate and identify a missing person. Project Lifesaver team members know how to approach an individual, gain their trust, put them at ease, and return them home safely.
